## **Juvenile Traffic Court Participants:**

The Delaware County 4-H conducts a program called Car teens at the Willis Government Building 2079 US Highway 23 North. This building is located behind McDonald's, next to Big Lots, and also houses the Board of Elections and the BMV. Please be advised of the following.

**IT IS MANDATORY TO ATTEND THE WORKSHOP UNLESS EXCUSED BY THE JUDGE OR MAGISTRATE. WHETHER YOU SERVE THE 4 OR 6 WEEKS LICENSE SUSPENSION, YOU AND A PARENT ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND AS AN ORDER OF THE COURT.**

- A parent must attend with the juvenile.
- A fee of \$20.00 payable in **cash only, no checks**, is charged to partially defray the costs of the program.
- The program begins promptly at 9 a.m. and concludes at 11 a.m.
- Registration is **not required** for Car teens
- Participants please arrive by 8:45 a.m.
- Cell phones must be turned off during the workshop.

***The Car teens program is not operated by nor is its content established by the Juvenile Court.***

**SECOND VIOLATION PROBATIONARY SUSPENSION**  
**REINSTATEMENT FEE**

Ohio Revised Code section 4510.31 was amended effective April 2, 2003 by authorizing the Juvenile Court to grant limited driving to juveniles whose driver's license are suspended for a second time. This is a mandatory license suspension. The following outlines the process that will occur if you have been adjudicated as a Juvenile Traffic Offender for the second time.

1. **Delaware County Juvenile Court has suspended the driver's license for a period of 90 days. Limited driving privileges may have been granted during the suspension; changes or additions must be submitted in writing.**
2. **The juvenile must complete a Juvenile Driver Improvement Course within the 90 days.**
3. **The juvenile must provide proof of attendance and completion of a remedial driving course to the court. Verification can be mailed to 140 N. Sandusky Street, Delaware, Ohio 43015; Attention Mandy Clements**
